BASS	CHORDS	COMPOSITION
F#	F# major	C# / F# / A#
A#	A# minor	C# / F / A#
C#	C# major	C# / F / G#
G#	G# major	C / D# / G#

CHORDS COMPOSITION

Here's how to play those chords :

- F# major



- A# minor



- C# major



- G# major



RHYTHMIC PATTERN

In order to play this song, you can use the following pattern :

- Bass + chord (arpeggio)

F# (x1)	F# major (x2)	C# / F# / A#
A# (x1)	A# minor (x2)	C# / F / A#
C# (x1)	C# major (x2)	C# / F / G#
G# (x1)	G# major (x2)	C / D# / G#

Introduction : Play this table 2 times

First verse : Play this table 4 times

First pre-chorus : Play this table twice

First chorus : Play this table 6 times.

Second verse : Play this table 4 times

Second pre-chorus : Play this table twice

Second chorus : play this table 6 times

Interlude : Play this table twice

Third chorus : Play this table 6 times
