CHORDS - LADY GAGA - ALWAYS REMEMBER US THIS WAY		
BASS	CHORDS	COMPOSITION
C	C major	C / E / G
A	A minor	C / E / A
F	F major	C / F / A
G	G major	D / G / B
A#	A# major	D / F / A#

CHORDS COMPOSITION

Here's how to play those chords :

- C major



- A minor



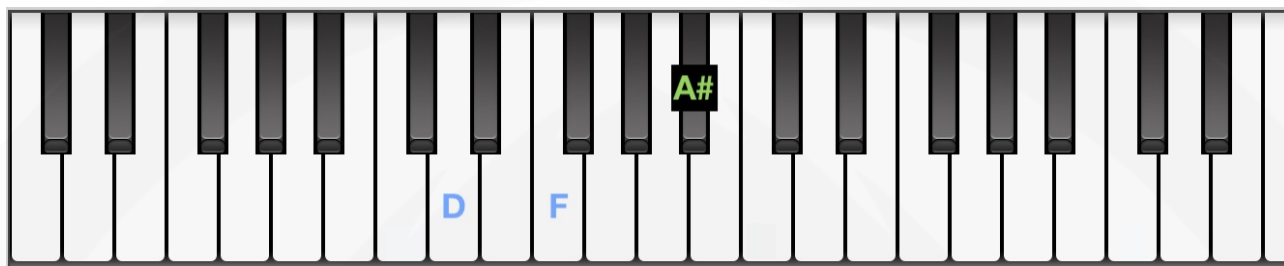
- F major



- G major



- A# major



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RHYTHMIC PATTERN

In order to play this song, you can use these 2 patterns :

1 / Bass + chord / Chord 3 times (total 4)

2 / Bass + chord / Chord / Bass played offbeat

Chord order for the first and second verse

CHORDS - LADY GAGA - ALWAYS REMEMBER US THIS WAY

BASS	CHORDS	COMPOSITION
A (x1)	A minor (x4)	C / E / A
F (x1)	F major (x4)	C / F / A
C (x1)	C major (x4)	C / E / G
G (x1)	G major (x4)	D / G / B

In order to play the first and second verse, you will need to play this table 2 times.

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Chord order for the first and second pre-chorus

CHORDS - LADY GAGA - ALWAYS REMEMBER US THIS WAY		
BASS	CHORDS	COMPOSITION
F (x1)	F major (x4)	C / F / A
C (x1)	C major (x4)	C / E / G
A (x1)	A minor (x4)	C / E / A
G (x1)	G major (x4)	D / G / B

In order to play the first and second pre-chorus, you will need to play this table once.

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Chord order for the first chorus

F (x1)	F major (x1)	C / F / A
G (x1)	G major (x1)	D / G / B
A (x1)	A minor (x1)	C / E / A
F (x1)	F major (x1)	C / F / A
G (x1)	G major (x1)	D / G / B
C (x1)	C major (x1)	C / E / G
REPEAT TWO TIMES		

In order to play the chorus, you will need to play this table once.

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Chord order for the second chorus

BASS	CHORDS	COMPOSITION
F (x1)	F major (x1)	C / F / A
G (x1)	G major (x1)	D / G / B
A (x1)	A minor (x2)	C / E / A
F (x1)	F major (x1)	C / F / A
G (x1)	G major (x1)	D / G / B
C (x1)	C major (x2)	C / E / G
F (x2)	F major (x2)	C / F / A
G (x2)	G major (x2)	D / G / B
A# (x4)	A# major (x8)	D / F / A#

Just like for the first chorus , in order to play the second chorus, you will also have to play this table once.

Chord order for the interlude + ouuuuh of Lady Gaga

CHORDS - LADY GAGA - ALWAYS REMEMBER US THIS WAY		
BASS	CHORDS	COMPOSITION
C (x2)	C major (x4)	C / E / G
A# (x2)	A# major (x4)	D / F / A#
F (x2)	F major (x4)	C / F / A
G (x2)	G major (x4)	D / G / B

In order to play the interlude, you will need to play this table once.
After, you will have to play the pre chorus, then a third chorus.

Chord order for the third chorus

BASS	CHORDS	COMPOSITION
F (x1)	F major (x1)	C / F / A
G (x1)	G major (x1)	D / G / B
A (x1)	A minor (x2)	C / E / A
F (x1)	F major (x1)	C / F / A
G (x1)	G major (x1)	D / G / B
C (x1)	C major (x2)	C / E / G
F (x1)	F major (x2)	C / F / A
G (x1)	G major (x2)	D / G / B
A (x2)	A minor (x4)	C / E / A

Play this table once and then play the next table with the first pattern :

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Chord order for the very last part (soft)

F (x1)	F major (x1)	C / F / A
