A	A major	C# / E / A
F#	F# minor	C# / F# / A
B	B minor	D / F# / B
G	G major	D / G / B

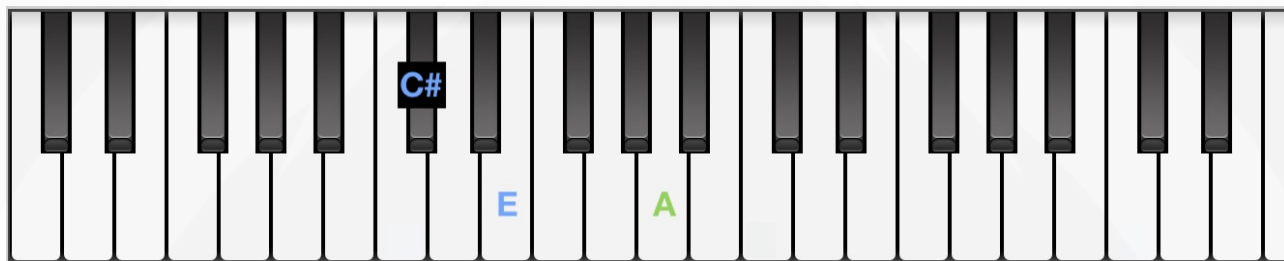

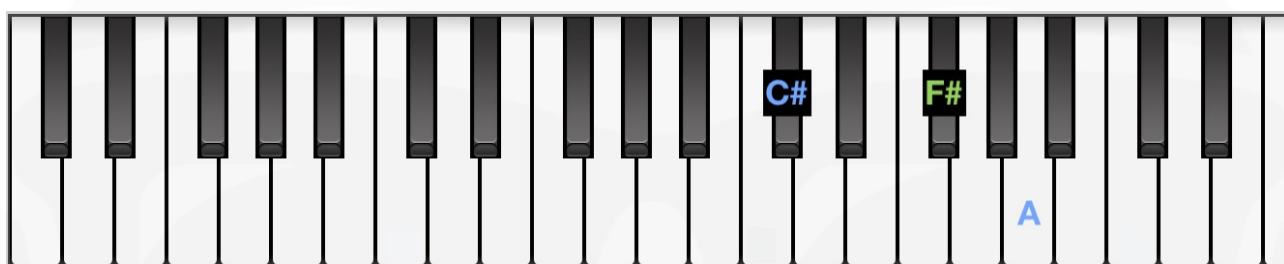
CHORDS COMPOSITION

Here's how to play those chords :

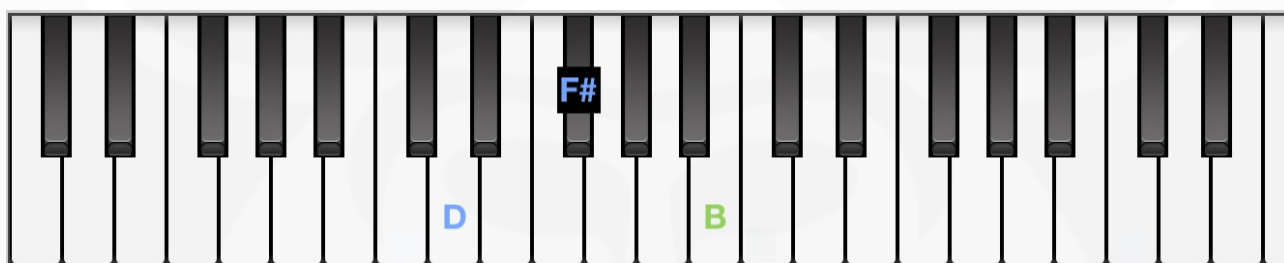
- A major



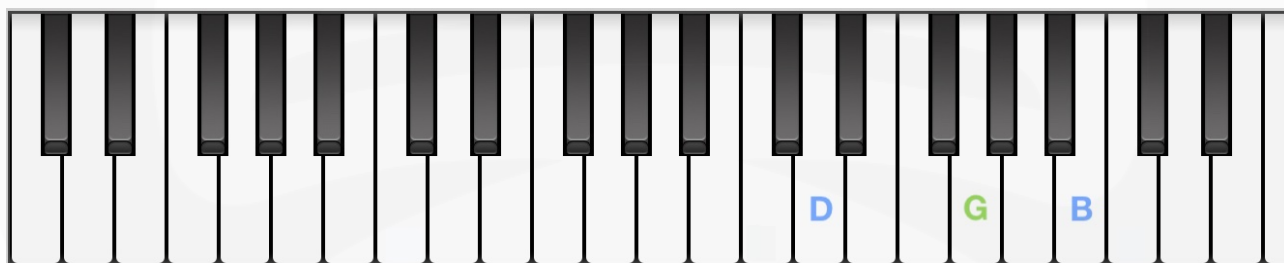
- F# minor



- B minor



- G major



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RHYTHMIC PATTERN

In order to play this song, you can use the following patterns :

- Bass + chord / Chord / Chord / Bass + chord
- Bass + Long chords

CHORDS ORDER FOR ALL VERSES

JUSTIN BIEBER - LONELY		
BASS	CHORDS	COMPOSITION
G (x2)	G major (x4)	D / G / B
F# (x2)	F# minor (x4)	C# / F# / A
B (x4)	B minor (x8)	D / F# / B

In order to play the 1st AND 2nd verse, you will need to play the table 2 times.

CHORDS ORDER FOR ALL CHORUS

JUSTIN BIEBER - LONELY		
BASS	CHORDS	COMPOSITION
G (x2)	G major (x4)	D / G / B
A (x2)	A major (x4)	C# / E / A
F# (x2)	F# minor (x4)	C# / F# / A
G (x2)	G major (x4)	D / G / B

In order to play the 1st AND 2nd chorus, you will need to play the table 2 times.

CHORDS ORDER FOR THE PRE CHORUS « I'm so lonely, lonely... »

JUSTIN BIEBER - LONELY		
BASS	CHORDS	COMPOSITION
G (x1)	G major (x1)	D / G / B
A (x1)	A major (x1)	C# / E / A
F# (x1)	F# minor (x1)	C# / F# / A
G (x1)	G major (x1)	D / G / B

In order to play the 1st pre chorus, you will need to play the table once.

In order to play the second pre chorus, you will need to play this table 2 times.
